Summary of Action Taken on Articles

ARTICLE #1 – Voted to accept the 2016 Annual Town Report presented.

ARTICLE #2 – Voted to authorize the Treasurer to borrow money from time to time.

ARTICLE #3 – Voted to authorize FY/18 Revolving Funds in accordance with MGL, C44,s53E1/2.

ARTICLE #4 – Voted to allow the Assessors to appoint one of its members to a full time position.

ARTICLE #5 – Voted to extend acceptance of MGL, C59s5, clause56.

ARTICLE #6 –Voted to transfer \$4,300. from Sale of Lots & Burial Fees to Cemetery Comm.

ARTICLE #7 – Voted to transfer \$2,449.15 from Cemetery Perpetual Care to Cemetery Comm. Expense Acct.

ARTICLE #8 – Voted to transfer \$25,000. From Free Cash to Reserve Fund.

ARTICLE #9 –Voted to borrow \$363,240.75 for town roads.

ARTICLE #10 – Voted to appropriate \$537,03.36 from Sewer Revenues to Water Pollution Control Facilities Enterprise Fund for operation of Gilbertville & Wheelwright Sewer Plants, of which \$60,761.67 is to reimburse the General Fund for indirect costs.

ARTICLE #11 – TABLED.

ARTICLE #12 – Voted to raise and appropriate \$5,125,423.41 for FY/2018 Budget.

ARTICLE #13 – Voted to transfer \$49,349.40 from Overlay Surplus to the Stabilization Account.

ARTICLE #14 – Voted to accept MGK, C64L,s2

ARTICLE #15 – Voted to transfer \$9,133.32 from Free Cash to purchase a multiline phone system for the Municipal Building.

ARTICLE #16 – Voted to transfer \$9,200. for engineering costs for a CSA Permit.

ARTICLE #17 – Voted to delete the bylaw entitled “A Bylaw Establishing Hardwick as a Nuclear Free Zone”.

ARTICLE #18 – Voted to delete from the General Bylaw “TAX COLLECTOR – NON-PAYMENT OF TAXES” the old version of MGL, C40,s57 and replace it with the updated version of MGL, C40s57.

ARTICLE #19 –Voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen to appoint the Town Treasurer.

ARTICLE #20 - Voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen to appoint the Town Collector.

ARTICLE #21 – Voted to accept a new General Bylaw entitled “Road Opening Permit Regulations”.
