## Talk With a Pharmacist About Immunizations and How They Keep You Healthy

Worcester, MA – On July 27<sup>th</sup>, a registered pharmacist from the MCPHS University Pharmacy Outreach Program will be on site at the Barre Council on Aging to give a presentation on immunizations. The program will begin at 1:00 pm. Following the presentation, participants will have the opportunity to meet one-on-one with a pharmacist to discuss immunizations and the medications they are taking. This, and all services of the Pharmacy Outreach Program, are free of charge to Massachusetts residents.

The Pharmacy Outreach Program is a community service project of MCPHS University sponsored in part by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Elder Affairs and the Central Massachusetts Agency on Aging. A team of case managers and pharmacists work together to ensure MA residents can afford their medications, take their medications correctly, and understand different insurance coverage options like Medicare.
