Learn about Natural Supplements with a Pharmacist on July 18th

Worcester, MA – On July 18th, a registered pharmacist from the MCPHS University Pharmacy Outreach Program will be on site at the Barre Council on Aging to give a program on safely using natural supplements. The program will begin at 1:00pm. Following the presentation, attendees will have the opportunity to meet one-on-one with a pharmacist to discuss the supplements and medications they are taking and ask questions. This, and all services of the Pharmacy Outreach Program, are free of charge to Massachusetts residents.

The Pharmacy Outreach Program is a community service project of MCPHS University sponsored in part by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Elder Affairs and the Central Massachusetts Agency on Aging. A team of case managers and pharmacists work together to ensure MA residents can afford their medications, take their medications correctly, and understand different insurance coverage options like Medicare.
