Re: Protest of approval pursuant to G.L. Ch. 128A § 13A

Petitions protesting the approval of a location, as voted by the Hardwick Board of Selectmen (BOS) on November 9, 2022, pursuant to G.L. Chapter 128A § 13A, have been filed with my office today.

As of November 9, 2022, there were (1,985) one thousand nine hundred eighty-five registered voters in Hardwick. The statutory requirement for those protesting against such approval taking effect is (239) two hundred thirty-nine registered voters. The Board of Registrars has certified a cumulative total of (335) three hundred thirty-five registered voters which is the statutory twelve percent of registered voters, plus an additional two fifths thereof as required by G.L. Chapter 53 § 7.
